


PERSONAL FIRST AID KIT

All Scouts sit on the floor in a semicircle. The leader introduces a new troop project: the first aid kit neckerchief slide. Tell how the kit's contents can take care of minor first aid problems such as:

- Minor cuts and scratches
- Headaches
- Blisters
- Bee stings and tick bites
- Arm sling (pin and neckerchief)

Distribute empty 35mm film cans, one to each Scout. Have a boy leader go over the list of contents that each Scout should fit in his own can:

- 1—3" x 3" gauze compress
- 2—plastic bandages
- 1—1" gauze bandage
- 6—aspirin tablets (wrap in foil)
- 1—large safety pin
- 1—roll of adhesive tape 1" wide
- 3—wood matchsticks (cut to fit)
- 1—quarter
- 1—piece of sandpaper for can bottom (match striker)



Add one piece of plastic garden hose, one inch long. Tape the piece of hose to the can as shown. Paint a red cross on the front. Show the samples done before the meeting. Ask Scouts to decorate their slides.
