FIRST AID-YOUR DUTIES

- > Stop life-threatening dangers
- > Keep victim safe from further harm
- Get proper medical help for the victim

TAKE CHARGE

- > Keep Calm
- Focus your attention on making people safe
- > Act with confidence
- Cheerfulness will help the victim and others around you lose their fear

APPROACH CAREFULLY

- Keep your own safety and the safety of other rescuers in mind
- > Be aware of everything around you
- Watch for other hazards

FIRST THINGS FIRST

- > Treat "Hurry Cases" immediately
- Send someone to phone for help
- Treat every accident victim for shock
- Examine the victim for other injuries that require first aid
- > Keep the victim comfortable until help arrives

GETTING HELP

WHO—Give your name and where you are calling

WHAT—Explain the emergency as fully as possible.

WHERE—Give directions to the location of the accident

Hello, this is Scout Joe Brown calling from 555-2222.

I'm reporting an explosion.

Several people are hurt.

Two are unconscious.

The accident is at the intersection of Highway 2 and Maple Street.



Find out whom to call and how to call for medical help. Keep coins for calls in case you have to call for help.
